CORE

Core Classes

Following the model of Jesus, we build relationships with people in three ways: one-onone, one-on-some, and one-on-many. Through a series of specific classes aligned with our five values called core classes, we teach the basics of following Jesus (i.e. how to pray, how to study the bible. how to serve, reach people, and worship). We take great joy in seeing you equipped, empowered, and engaged to live a life of purpose and influence.

Connect is a basic introduction to our church family, and is designed to clearly explain who and what our church is. This class is a prerequisite class for membership.

Grow will help you develop the spiritual habits you need to jump start your spiritual growth. Serve will teach you how God can use your spiritual gifts, abilities, personality, and experiences to serve and minister to the needs of others.

Reach will teach you how to reach everyone with the gospel of Jesus—from your neighbors to every corner of the world!

Worship will teach you the biblical principles of worship and why worshiping Jesus individually and as a group is important.

How do I find a group or class at LCC?

What types of groups and classes are available at LCC?

Life groups meet in homes and are the primary way we build community. We also offer women's groups, men's groups, support groups, and more, which are built around common interests, gender, or life stage. LCC University is made up of classes and bible studies that we offer each spring and fall semester at LCC on Monday and Thursday nights from 6:30 - 8:00pm.

Can I be in a life group and participate in other groups and classes? Yes! For example, you may be in a life group, but also take one of the classes being featured in our fall semester. Or you might be part of a life group and an additional group based on your interests. It's all about experiencing life together and becoming the disciple-maker God designed all of us to be.
